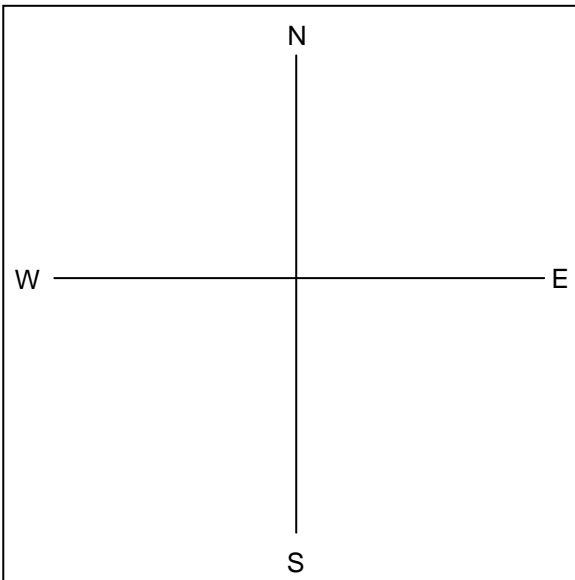

GULLY STABILIZATION PROGRAM

OBJECTIVE: To prevent soil erosion by stabilizing eroded gullies.

DEFINITION OF ELIGIBILITY: Any eroded gully where stabilization will prevent further erosion. Gullies are typically caused by water jumping out of a continuous runway or by heavy rainstorms.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF GULLY STABILIZATION PROGRAM

LANDOWNER RESPONSIBILITY:

1. Complete the application in full.
2. Provide consent of entry for inspection and construction.
3. Provide sufficient room for construction, and open and close fences as required for construction.
4. Remove all brush piles, stones and other debris after construction.
5. Maintain the gully to prevent future erosion.

BOARD RESPONSIBILITY

1. Determine application priorities/approval on the recommendation of Whitemud Watershed Conservation District and the Rural Municipality.
2. To recommend the stabilization measure required.
