PURPOSE:

The purpose of the program is to encourage water conservation. The Board will consider projects with multiple benefits as opposed to dams with a single purpose such as watering for livestock. The decision of the Board regarding project approval is final.

COST-SHARING:

The landowner will contribute 25% of the total costs and the Board will contribute 75% of the total cost.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Landowners requesting a water storage project will complete the Water Storage Application Form.
- 2. The completed application form is submitted to the District who may request a survey, design or cost estimate.
- 3. Applications are brought to Sub-district meetings for approval/non-approval.
- 4. Once an application is approved, the landowner will be asked to complete a Water Storage Agreement. The agreement will then be registered with the Land Titles Office in order to protect the Board's investment in the dam.
