- To remove livestock pressure from water sources and provide alternate watering sources to livestock managers
- To provide assistance for beneficial management practices of pasture lands

#### **Landowner Responsibilities:**

- 1. Projects applied for must be within the Whitemud District.
- 2. Application can be made by a renter, but needs approval from the owner of the land.
- 3. Only one application per family farm.
- 4. Crown Land projects qualify if lessee is eligible.
- 5. Establish projects on land as designated on approved application form.
- 6. Sign a 5 year GROW agreement stating responsibilities of landowner and Watershed.
- 7. Cannot remove any part of the project that is under a term agreement.
- 8. Maintain project as stated in agreement or forfeit participated in all future Watershed Programs
- 9. Allow Watershed staff on property for reasons concerning the project.
