- To remove livestock pressure from water sources and provide alternate watering sources to livestock managers,
- To provide assistance for beneficial management practices of pasture lands.

Landowner Responsibilities:

1. Projects applied for must be within the Whitemud District.
2. Application can be made by a renter, but needs approval from the owner of the land.
3. Only one application per family farm.
4. Crown Land projects qualify if lessee is eligible.
5. Establish projects on land as designated on approved application form.
6. Sign an agreement stating responsibilities of landowner and Watershed.
7. Cannot remove any part of the project that is under a term agreement.
8. Maintain project as stated in agreement or forfeit participated in all future Watershed Programs
9. Allow Watershed staff on property for reasons concerning the project.

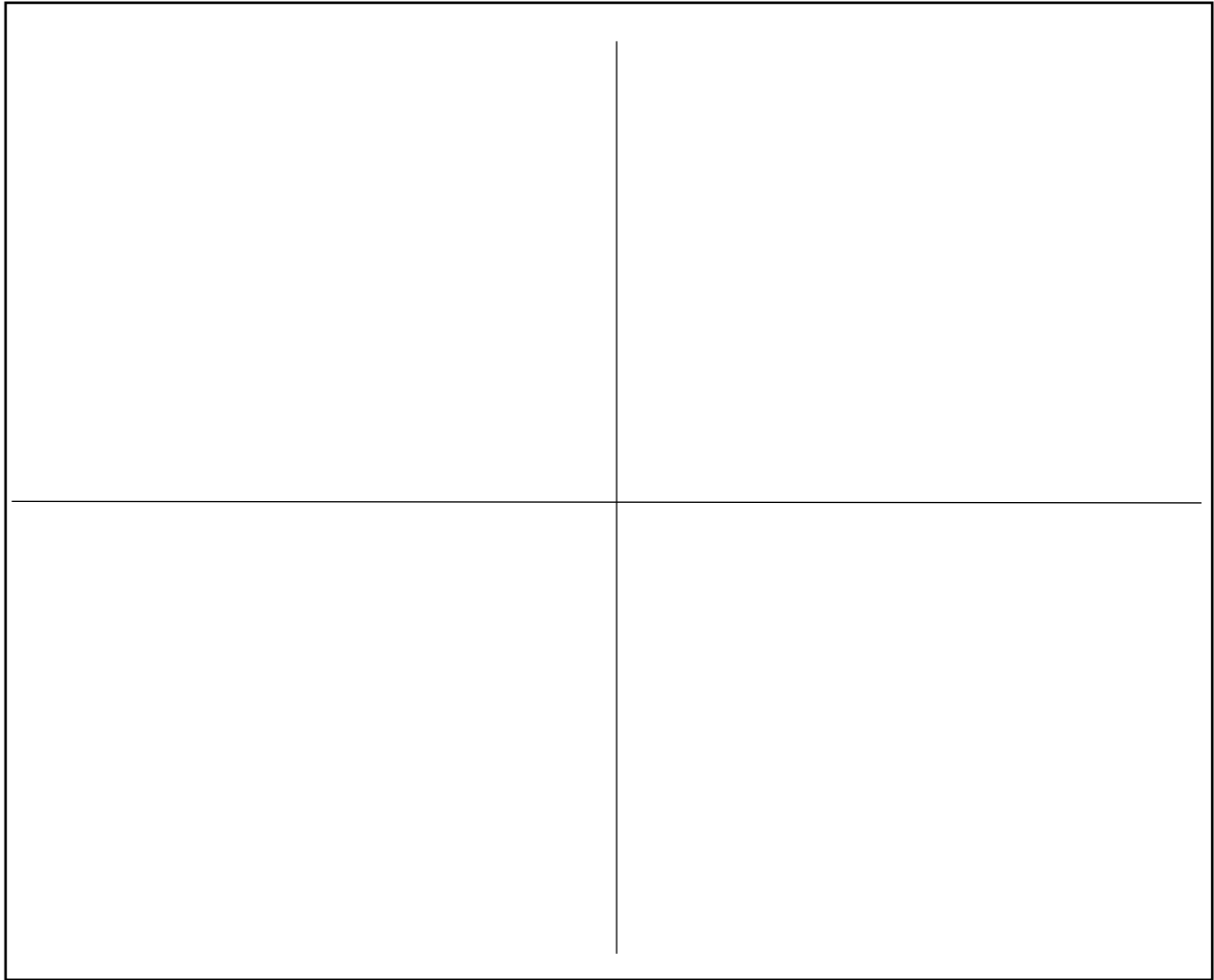
